

Action Plan for Mine Risk Education in Jordan

1 April 2006 to 1 April 2007

Every school in an affected area will receive mine risk education from the Jordan Red Crescent Society and other relevant bodies and organizations, in coordination with the National Committee for Demining and Rehabilitation and the Ministry of Education, before the 1st of April 2007.

The National Committee for Demining and Rehabilitation will establish a capacity to coordinate the mine risk education program and to monitor the effectiveness of mine risk education projects and activities by the end of 2006.

The Hashemite Charitable Society for Soldiers with Special Needs (HSSSN) and the Landmine Survivors Network (LSN) MRE will each identify by May 2006 at least five mine and UXO victims who can be trained by other bodies and organizations as mine risk education facilitators.

The NCDR will convene regular (at least once every month) mine risk education coordination meetings of concerned bodies and organizations. A specific meeting will be organized to ensure that the information needs of mine risk education are addressed by the landmine impact survey to be conducted in Jordan.

The NCDR with its partners will ensure the development and adoption of national standards for mine risk education by the end of 2006.

The NCDR will call on relevant national and international expertise to support a workshop on the training of mine risk education trainers no later than the autumn of 2006. It will identify trainers from government ministries and bodies and national organizations to participate in the workshop and coordinate the development of a plan for their subsequent training of facilitators.

The NCDR will convene a planning workshop before the end of 2006 to prepare a mine risk education operational plan in 2007.
